Rules 2014

The following are rules that we have found to be helpful to the success of our trips. We want the trips to be empowering experiences for each camper, we want the trips to be fun and to be learning experiences. In order for all this to happen we do need to have some common rules for all to abide by.

- Cooperate with the leaders and other campers. Respect quiet time, private space and personal needs
- When you are on the bike your helmet is on. When your helmet is on it is buckled.
- Let the leaders know when you leave the group.
- When you leave the group always be with a partner.
- Ride on the right side of the road or trail, not on sidewalks.
- No radios, ipods, cell phones, foul language, put downs, put down jokes, alcohol, drugs or sexual activity.
- Everyone eats camp food (if there is a special need, tell the leader before the trip).
- Use equipment safely and with respect, especially knives. Return equipment where it belongs.
- Only swim when one of the leaders is present.
- Wear a life jacket when canoeing/kayaking/rafting and have it buckled.
- Keep the fire in the fire. Burn only items that will cause no harm.
- Everyone helps with chores.
- Leave an area cleaner than when you came.
- Respect each other and others in the campground and all living creatures.
- Phone calls home will be once a day at a designated time or anytime in the case of an emergency.
- SOAC Inc. Board and Camp Director reserve the right to refuse participation to a camper for serious behavioral reasons.
